It's a match (process)!

Matching in the program is **self-led** which means that **both** mentors and mentees are in charge of choosing their partner. You will create your profile on our mentoring platform where you'll get best match recommendations **based on availability, location, mentoring areas of help,** and other criteria.

Once you find someone you'd like to pair up with, you will send a request and wait for the mentor's answer. If the mentor accepts, you will be paired and can schedule your first call. If your request is not accepted don't worry, you can request other mentors or ask the Women Go Tech team to assign you one based on your profile.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What are the requirements to be admitted to the program?

A: Criteria for the participant candidates are:

- **Motivation and determination**. You should have taken some of the steps toward the tech world before entering the program. Courses, books, seminars, self-learning activities anything works if it proves your will!
- Ability to set professional goals. Goals provide a roadmap for your personal and professional development and help you maximize the benefits of the mentorship experience.
- Basic English communication skills. All communication and program's activities are held in English so you should be able to understand and speak English.
- **LinkedIn profile**. We (and your future employers) want to see your professional journey! If you don't have a LinkedIn account yet, this is a good time to start one.
- **18+** years old.

Q: Why is the program in English? What if I am not fluent in it?

A: Succeeding in the tech world and building a career is much easier if you speak and understand English. Most of the newest industry materials, courses and books are in English, international tech companies are looking for employees who are fluent in English as well.

Do not worry if your skills aren't perfect or haven't used them for a while - with all the sessions being in English, soon you will revive your knowledge and it'll be a great help for your future career!

Q: Where do I have to be located to attend this program?

A: You can join from anywhere in Europe! While this program is promoted to women in the CEE region, we believe that women's inclusion in tech is an important topic globally.

Q: How will the participant selection process look like?

A: You will need to fill out an online participant application form. We will ask you to provide information about yourself, your motivation and expectations. Q: What is the time commitment?

A: Time commitment for mentorship sessions will vary based on agreement with your mentor but it will not be less than 2 hours per month. Other program's activities such as events will require 2-4 hours of your time per month.
